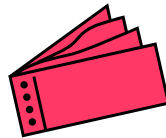

Earthquake and Tsunami disaster in Japan

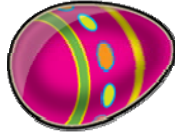

We will also be holding an Easter crown competition "Spring Theme".

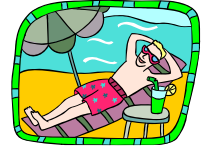


Easter Egg Hunt
